



Save Rural Loudoun

Suggested Messages to County Supervisors

September 2020

Save Rural Loudoun recommends that citizens wishing for strengthened rural preservation measures ask the supervisors for the following:

- Please reduce the number of houses that can be built in rural “clustered subdivisions.” At the very least, Loudoun should not provide more commercial incentives to destroy farmland than our neighboring counties.
- Please protect prime farmland. Houses, septic fields and other residential infrastructure should not be built on Loudoun’s best farming soils.
- Please ensure that clustered subdivisions don’t compromise the water supplies or water quality for neighboring properties or the rest of Loudoun.
- Please implement and adequately fund a “Purchase of Development Rights” program.
